
Regional average wages per job are £3.0k below the national average wages of £36.2k per job.







Job Trends






Millennials

Racial diversity is low in Cheshire West and Chester. The national average for an area this size is 73,658 racially diverse people, while there are 23,035 here.








Largest Industries






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GVA






Top Industry Wages








Top Growing Occupations


Top Occupation Wages




