Regional average wages per job are £405 below the national average wages of £36.2k per job.






2023 Labour Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment



2024 Age Cohort Demographics







Job Trends






Millennials

Racial diversity is low in Warrington. The national average for an area this size is 42,155 racially diverse people, while there are 18,003 here.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GVA






Top Industry Wages








Top Growing Occupations


Top Occupation Wages




